ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT - BRIDGEWATER POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS: Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 44, §53A and 53A1/2, states as follows:

An officer of any city or town may accept grants or gifts of funds or tangible property from an individual or private corporation, ... and may expend such funds or use such tangible property for the purposes of such grant or gift ... with the approval of the city manager and city council...; and

WHEREAS: The Town of Bridgewater has received a gift from Chuckran’s Auto Parts of police protection equipment to be used by the Police Department;

Now, therefore, in accordance with Chapter 44, §53A and §53A1/2 of the Massachusetts General Laws, the Town Council votes to take the following action:

ORDERED that the Town Council of Bridgewater, Massachusetts in Town Council assembled vote to accept the gift of Police Protective Equipment from Chuckran’s Auto Parts and to expend or use the gift in accordance with stated purpose thereof.

Explanation:

Alan Churckran, Andrew Chuckran and Richard Chuckran from Chuckran Auto Parts on Plymouth Street have donated police protective equipment. Acceptance of this gift will allow the Police Department to better protect officers in the field.
