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June 13, 2022 Meeting

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY VP, DIANE ROZA. OUR CHAIRMAN, DAVID FRIM, WAS UNABLE TO BE WITH US TODAY.

SUBCOMMITTEE REPORT: NONE

ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE: NO REPORT

TREASURER'S REPORT:

GLORIA GAVE US AN UPDATE ON THE HOWARD FOUNDATION. AS OF YET THEY HAVE NOT RESPONDED TO OUR REQUEST.

WE WILL CONTINUE TO SEEK A RESPONSE.

COA REVOLVING FUND: WE SPENT \$1520.00 WITH A BALANCE OF \$237.00. THIS FUND PAYS FOR OUR WELLNESS CLASSES, AND TRANSPORTATION, ETC.

NEEDY SENIORS: WE HAVE \$2503.08 IN THE ACCOUNT. WE HOPE TO COME UP WITH A NEW NAME FOR THIS ACCOUNT. THERE IS A PROCESS INVOLVED THOUGH - WE JUST CAN'T CHANGE THE NAME. IT WILL PROBABLY BE CALLED "FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE".

MISCELLANEOUS: WE SPENT \$6991.00 THE BALANCE IS \$37,643.85. THE NEW TENT WAS A LARGE EXPENSE AND THERE WAS ALREADY \$2000.00 IN THE FUND.

NUTRITION: WE SPENT \$1908.81 WITH A BALANCE OF \$12976.51.

BISTRO MEALS AND ST. PATRICK'S MEAL WAS PAID WITH THIS FUND.

FRENCH DOOR: THE INTERIOR IS COMPLETE. THEY ARE WORKING ON OUTDOOR LIGHTING AND INSIDE FLOORING. IT CAME IN \$1000 UNDER BUDGET.

NO NEW UPDATES ON THE ROOF AND PORTICO.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION: MILLING WAS GOING ON TODAY AND REPAVING WILL TAKE PLACE TOMORROW AND THE NEXT DAY.

THE GAS STOVE WAS TURNED BACK ON.

NEW TENT: THE BFD WILL BE INSTALLING IT. GRANT RENTAL DONATED 20 USED CHAIRS.



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**DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

IT WILL BE NICE WHEN THE ROAD WORK IS DONE!

ACTIVITIES HAVE DECLINED.

A SMALL FEE IS CHARGED FOR ALL CLASSES.

THERE HAS NOT BEEN A GOOD TURNOUT FOR VIRTUAL CLASSES.

WE MIGHT NEED TO CHANGE THINGS UP IN JULY.

REVAMPING TRANSPORTATION WITH BSU AND A&A METRO.

MAYBE DO AN ANALYSIS OF WHERE OUR BUS GOES AND INCREASE FEES MAINLY DUE TO THE RISE IN FUEL. RIGHT NOW THE FEE IS \$2.50 PER WAY = \$5.00 PER ROUND TRIP. RIDERSHIP IS LOW AND PARTICIPATION IN ACTIVITIES IS LOW TOO.

NUTRITION: CONGREGATE LUNCH IS LOW IN ATTENDANCE (ONLY 3 IN PERSON!) DELIVERY OF LUNCHES IS HIGH.

THERE ARE NOW 70 CLIENTS FOR MEALS ON WHEELS. BISTRO MEALS (\$5.00) IS UP TO 71 WITH PERHAPS 11 TO EAT IN. PARTICIPANTS MUST SIGN UP IN ADVANCE.

THE COST FOR THE MEMORIAL DAY BBQ FOR PICK UP IS \$8.00. \$5.00 FOR BISTRO PEOPLE. THE COST DIFFERENCE FOR PICK UP IS BECAUSE THE COST OF PACKAGING MEALS HAS GONE WAY UP.

MISCELLANEOUS DONATIONS WILL PAY FOR THE MOTHER'S DAY LUNCH. TWENTY PEOPLE HAVE SIGNED UP FOR THIS MEAL. AFTERWARD PARTICIPANTS WILL GO OUTSIDE AND GET A LITTLE EXERCISE BY WALKING AROUND THE PROPERTY. TRIAD WILL BE DOING A SAFE DRIVING PROGRAM FOR SENIORS.

PICKLE-BALL IS THRIVING! JOE AND JOYCE PITTA ARE INSTRUCTORS EVERY WEDNESDAY MORNING. IT IS A FREE CLASS. HOPEFULLY WE WILL HAVE A SENIOR PICKLE-BALL LEAGUE!

ALICE'S CAFE - THEY MEET BI-WEEKLY. THEY ARE GOING ON A FIELD TRIP TO JUST CLAYING AROUND - THERE IS A 10 PERSON LIMIT.
